Up to 12 applicants will be awarded scholarships to participate.

Students will arrive at Clondeboye on the evening of 10th August and will work daily with the Artists-in-Residence and also have the opportunity to attend their rehearsals and concerts. On the evening of 16th August masterclass participants will perform in a public concert. Masterclass participants will be eligible and considered for a number of substantial prizes and awards based on their work and performances during the Festival.

Application Details

Eligibility

The masterclasses are open to all musicians born on the island of Ireland or whose parents were born in Ireland. Students who do not meet these criteria but who have lived on the island of Ireland for a substantial part of their life may also apply. Applicants must have been born on or after **1st September 1990**.

Repertoire

Successful applicants will be required to prepare a work or movement from a work (approx. 10-12 mins) for performance in recital with an accompanist (solo work in the case of pianists). They will also have the opportunity to bring whatever repertoire they are currently working on to the masterclasses.

General

Masterclasses, accommodation and food are provided free. Participants will live on site at Clandeboye Courtyard (<http://www.clandeboye.co.uk/>) for the duration of the Festival. Travel to and from the Festival will be the responsibility of each participant.
