The Camerata Ireland Academy is open to:

- Advanced students aged 16 – 26 (28 for singers)
- Students from or resident in Ireland – North or South

*Some exceptions to these criteria may be made at the discretion of the panel*

Applications are invited from the following:

- Piano
- Violin
- Viola
- Cello
- Woodwind
- Brass
- Voice

You must submit the following

1. A short résumé of your musical experience to date.
2. 2 high quality, recent recordings, one of which should be from the classical period\*

3. A high-quality head shot.
4. A performance biography of no more than 250 words.

*\*Please choose 2 pieces of music you would ideally like to work on in the masterclass and also the music (no more than 15 minutes) you would like to record for the panel to be considered for the selection of 3 finalists who will go forward.*

**All applicants are required to agree to the following:**

That upon being accepted to take part in the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Camerata Ireland Academy, they undertake to appear online at the agreed time. They also agree to any reasonable media or general publicity requirements organised by the Academy. They accept that they may be asked to fulfil public engagements or concerts by Camerata Ireland for a period of one year. A reasonable honorarium will be offered for these engagements.

These 3 finalists will be afforded performance opportunities and should remain available for an appearance or appearances at the Clondeboye Festival between 17th and 27th August 2022. There will be other performances offered (to be notified at a later date).
